BE SEEN

Keep your eye out for these yellow signs at intersections throughout the city, reminding pedestrians to make eye contact with drivers before crossing the street.

Safety tips for drivers:

- Remember that the faster you go, the deadlier your car is
- Follow the speed limit
- Look for pedestrians
- When you are turning right, look left AND look right to look for pedestrians
- Never use your phone while driving
- Never drive under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs
- Pedestrians have the right of way at any crosswalk or intersection
- Stop at the crosswalk stop line to give drivers in other lanes an opportunity to see pedestrians

Safety tips for pedestrians:

- “LOOK” Make eye contact with drivers
- Look left-right-left and behind you before crossing the street
- Look before you step! Cross streets at crosswalks/intersections, obey traffic signals and watch for turning vehicles
- “BE SEEN” Wear bright colored clothing
- “LISTEN” Sometimes you can hear a car before you see it
- Walk where it is safe, on the sidewalk. If there is no sidewalk, walk facing traffic
- Stay off the phone and pay attention to your surroundings
